History AutoCAD was originally developed and marketed by Autodesk, Inc., a company that was founded by Paul Case in 1982. It was initially released in a DOS version named "AutoCAD". The name "AutoCAD" was a combination of "auto" and "CAD", referring to the ease of use of the program and its ability to help users design or make drawings of their objects or designs. Case wanted to create a program that would be easy to use and understandable for the general public. The first version of AutoCAD, developed in 1982 and published in December, was designed to run on the early Apple II computer. It had the user enter information such as the length of an object to be drawn and then calculate the path on the screen for the object. It also could read blocks of text, and create a library of these objects from the information that was entered. This was an early indication of the increasing importance of 3D modeling in the world of design software. The company decided to shift AutoCAD into the Windows environment, and it was first introduced in September 1987 as "AutoCAD LT" for DOS. The "LT" stands for "low-cost" and reflected the way in which the company decided to advertise the product. "AutoCAD LT" was initially designed to run on a 286 PC with a low-resolution screen that could display 256 colors. By 1990, the original version of "AutoCAD LT" was upgraded to run on a 386 PC, and the model was called "AutoCAD" instead of "AutoCAD LT". "AutoCAD" would remain the title of the program until the release of AutoCAD 2005. AutoCAD was initially licensed to a single user for a single type of PC and a single price. Subsequent versions were later sold to multiple users on a per-user basis. The first versions of AutoCAD were all DOS-based, but by the late 1990s, the OSs supported by the program had shifted to Windows 3.0

Many user created plug-ins also extend natively the AutoCAD application.
